

MONROE SWAP MEET VENDOR FAQ

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **How do I preregister for the Car Corral?**

1. You can not preregister. Just show up with \$40 cash per space starting at 12:00 p.m. Friday or 6:00 a.m. on Saturday or Sunday. You can bring your vehicle on Friday and leave it all weekend. The gate is closed and there is Roving Security from closing to opening.

- **How are the dates chosen?**

1. Columbus Day weekend
2. Canadian Thanksgiving weekend

- **Can I bring my dog/cat etc into the Swap Meet or Car Corral?**

1. No

- **If I am a vendor when can I set up?**

1. Friday at about 2:00 p.m.
2. Saturday and Sunday 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.

- **As a vendor when can I move out?**

1. Because there will be general public on the fairgrounds no vehicle traffic is allowed until after the meet is closed for the day. You may hand carry out earlier if necessary.

- **When do I need to make my reservations?**

1. Returning 2016 vendors have until July 1st to mail their application and payment if you wish to keep the same spaces you had in 2016, other wise all spaces are first come first served after the 4th of July.
2. Spaces will be sold on Friday October 6th after about 9:00 a.m until about 8:00 p.m. and on Saturday October 7th from about 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.

- **Refunds and stall changes**

1. Prior to Swap Meet weekend vendors must return you receipt and vehicle gate passes to arrive at the 19064 Sulfer Springs Rd, Mount Vernon, WA 98274 prior to October 1st. After October 5th, 2017 you must bring your receipt and vehicle gate passes to the Swap Meet office in the 600 building for **Stall Changes only NO REFUNDS.**

- **Can I prepay for the 2018 Swap Meet?**

1. No

- **I mailed my registration and payment late. How do I get my receipt and vehicle gate passes?**

1. Any payments received 10 days prior to the Swap Meet, your receipt and vehicle gate passes will not be mailed back to you. They will be available at the vendor entrance gate "**PAID WILL CALL**". If you have reserved your spot but not paid for them you must go to the Swap Meet office in the 600 building to pay your fee and receive your receipt and vehicle gate passes.

- **What happens if it rains?**

1. **The show must go on. This is Washington, bring your umbrellas or tents.**

- **Can I sell bottled water, snacks or other food items?**
- 1. No, there are vendors on the Swap Meet site that have arranged with the Fairgrounds exclusively to sell food and beverages..
- **I am bringing more than one vehicle to the Swap Meet. Do I need a pass for each vehicle?**
- 1. Yes, every vehicle that is allowed onto the Fairgrounds Swap Meet must have a mirror hanger that has the location of the vendors stall written on the face of the hanger.
- 2. When you register your application has a space to indicate how many gate/parking passes you require. If you leave this space blank you will receive one pass. Additional passes will be made available in the Swap Meet Office only. No additional passes will be mailed after your original pass is sent to you.

What are the general rules for the Swap Meet?

General Rules

- **AARC is not responsible for fire, theft or injury**
- **Food sales by vendors is prohibited.**
- **Vendors must hand carry out all merchandise if leaving prior to closing of public hours**
- **All items and refuse must be removed by the vendor from their spaces at the end of the Meet.**
- **No Dogs or other pets are allowed in the Swap Meet or Car Corral areas.**
- **Weapons, including but not limited to firearms, knives, BB guns, pellet guns or any other items that may be considered weapons are not to be carried, bought or sold on the Fairgrounds or surrounding area.**
- **No open flames, fuel or pop up canopies are allowed inside buildings.**
